

Arab and Muslim American Studies Minor Checklist*

**This is a basic checklist for the Arab and Muslim American Studies minor requirements. Exceptions & substitutions may be approved in consultation with the AMAS undergraduate advisor. Students are also encouraged to incorporate study abroad and/or the Honors program into their plan. All students should meet regularly with the AMAS advisor to ensure satisfactory progress toward completion of all requirements.*

<p>The AMAS minor requires a minimum of 15 credits distributed as follows;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● One 200-level course in Arab and Muslim American Studies (3 – 4 credits) ● At least two additional courses (6 credits) in Arab and Muslim American Studies ● Two additional courses (6 credits) in Arab and Muslim American Studies or in another department (AAPITS, ANTHRCUL, ENGLISH, HISTORY, SOC, etc...(or others approved by the AMAS Advisor) ● At least one (approved) course must be at the 300 or 400-level. ● One 300 or 400 level Arabic course can be applied towards the minor. However, a 400-level Arabic course does not fulfill the requirement for a 400-level course. <p>One course in the AMAS minor can overlap with one's major. In other words, only one class can double count towards both a student's major and minor.</p>	<p>Credits</p> <p>15</p>
