The AMAS minor requires a minimum of 15 credits distributed as follows;		Credits
 One 200-level course in Arab and Muslim American Studies (3 – 4 credits) 		15
At least two additional courses (6 credits) in Arab and Muslim American Studies		
 Two additional courses (6 credits) in Arab and Muslim American Studies or in another department (AAPITS, ANTHRCUL, ENGLISH, HISTORY, SOC, etc(or others approved by the AMAS Advisor) 		
 At least one (approved) course must be at the 300 or 400-level. 		
 One 300 or 400 level Arabic course can be applied towards the minor. However, a 400-level Arabic course does not fulfill the requirement for a 400-level course. 		
One course in the AMAS minor can overlap with one's major. In other words, only one class can double count towards both a student's major and minor.
