Academic Minor Program (15-credits)

- 1) At least three courses in Asian Studies (ASIAN) offered through the Department of Asian Languages and Cultures within one regional area: Chinese Studies, Japanese Studies, Korean Studies, South Asian Studies, or Southeast Asian Studies.
- 2) Two courses must be elected at the 300-level or above. Students may not use 100-level classes toward the minor plan.
- 3) An academic minor plan may also be organized around disciplines or lines of inquiry not necessarily defined by a region (e.g. Asian literature, film, religion, etc.).

◆ All courses must be approved by an ALC academic advisor.

◆ No course will count toward the minor unless the student receives a grade of C- or better.

◆ Twelve of the credits must be elected at the University of Michigan- Ann Arbor or at an overseas program associated with the university.

◆ No language (ASIANLAN) courses can be counted towards this program.
