

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

CHEMSTAND

Every accident or incident involving a student must be reported to and handled by appropriate Chemistry staff.

If the injury is life-threatening, call **911** immediately and tell them you are located in the lower atrium of the Chemistry building.

Then contact, in order, until someone is reached

Or if the situation is NOT life-threatening follow this list.
