Sail Champion Intern

MHA is seeking an intern for MHA's Sail Champion youth sailing program. Embarking on its 11th season, the Sail Champion program serves primarily disadvantaged youth by immersing them in hands-on, challenge-based single-day and five-day programs that teach them sailing and maritime history skills, as well as, teamwork, trust and self-confidence. The intern will work alongside MHA's captain and volunteers to plan, coordinate and implement both on-shore and on-water programming for groups of up to six youth at a time. The ideal candidate will be: a strong communicator, eager to work with youth 12+ from varying backgrounds, possess strong organization skills, and have experience in program development and/or delivery.

MHA's Sail Champion Intern will be supervised by MHA's Executive Director and the Sail Champion Captain (when under sail). The intern will participate in a general orientation, training on maritime history, and on-shore and on-board training on traditional sailing skills.
