GRADUATE STUDENT INITIATIVES

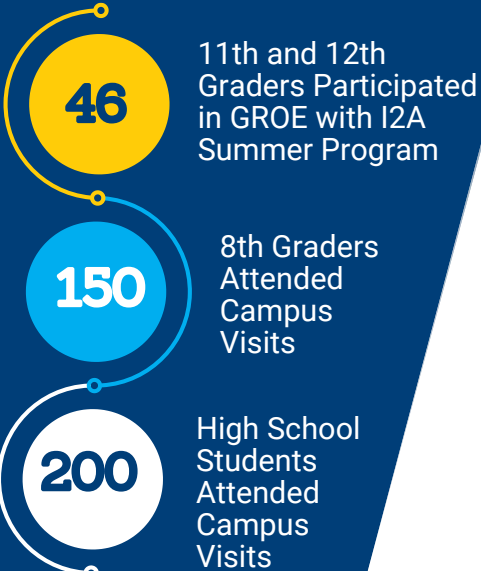
PhD Need-Based Technology Support Grant Program

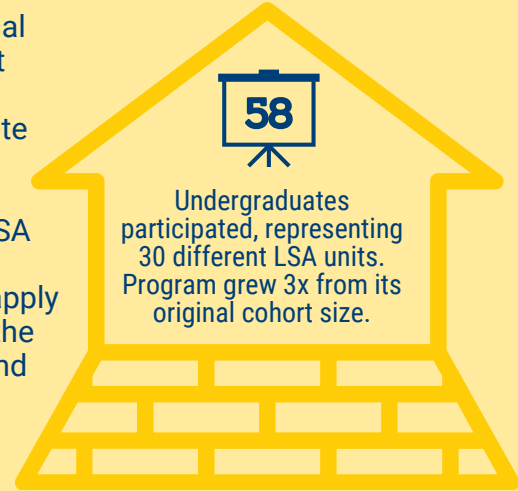

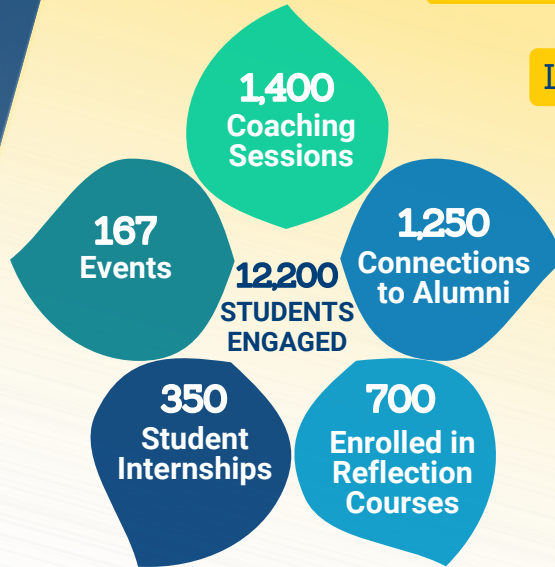
Foundations of DEI in the Workplace

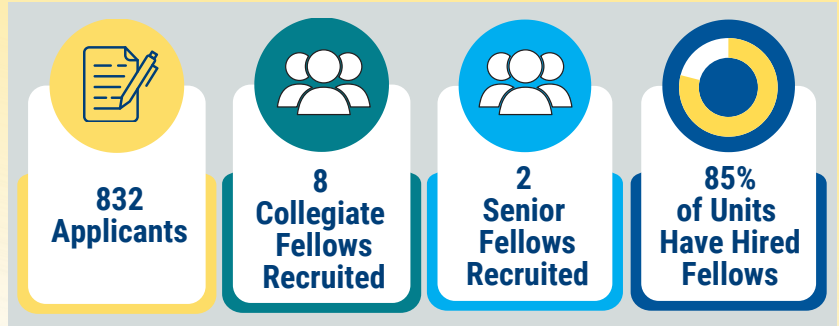
Race and Ethnicity Summer Course Development Grants
