One of the key responsibilities of the Office of the Assistant Dean is the resolution of cases of academic misconduct. All cases of alleged misconduct should be referred to our office for adjudication. Detailed information of the reporting process can be found on the <u>Academic Integrity Website</u>. You may also contact our office (764-7297) if it would be useful to consult with us before reporting a case.

For students completing their sophomore year, this is an important term because it is typically when they make decisions about declaring a major or minor. As the term progresses, some students may look to you for advice about majors and minors in your department. It may be helpful to check with your departmental advisor for program information to pass on to students. Another resource for undeclared students is the annual Major/Minor Expo which is a good opportunity for students to learn about many LSA academic majors and minors. This year's Expo is scheduled for Wednesday, March 23, 11:00 am to 3:00 pm, in the Michigan Union Ballroom.

Monday, April 18 Classes End Saturday, April 30 Commencement
