Application Checklist & Agreement Form

Checklist

In order to be eligible for the program, interested teachers must complete and submit the following materials:

- Completed Application Form, Checklist, and signed Agreement Form (this document)
- Work Plan (150-250 words outlining how you plan to incorporate the program into your class curriculum)
- Letter of Support from the Principal of your School (or another senior school administrator)

All application materials must be submitted electronically (documents in PDF or Word format) to the Google Form by the listed deadline. Any questions can be sent to outreachkorea@umich.edu with “KFSSP Application [Insert name of your school]” as the subject line of your e-mail.

Program Agreement

If awarded the Korea from A Single Shard Program, the Nam Center agrees to provide the following for your class:

1. A classroom set of the Newbery Award-winning YA novel “A Single Shard” by Linda Sue Park (up to 30 books)
2. A “Single Shard” Companion Korea Kit for use in the classroom. The responsible teacher will be provided with a return UPS label to ship back to the Nam Center at the end of a 10-day loan period.
3. A bus subsidy, with support from the University of Michigan Museum of Art (UMMA), to offset the cost of busing up to \$500. This will be reimbursed to the school upon presentation of an invoice for the bus. The bus will be used to visit UMMA and participate in a docent tour of the museum’s Gallery of Korean Art and related collections on a date pre-arranged with the Nam Center’s Outreach Coordinator.
4. An interactive Shipwreck Dig where up to 30 students will work in teams to excavate model shipwrecks, putting together clues to track the ancient trading routes of celadon. If your school does not allow field trips at this time, we will offer an in-class visit for the activity.

All components of this program are awarded annually as a single package to Michigan-area educators on a competitive basis. Multiple grants may be available each year depending on interests and funding. Schools must be within 1.5 hours driving time from U-M Ann Arbor. Once awarded the program, the responsible teacher agrees to submit a **program implementation report**, detailing how the materials provided by the Nam Center and UMMA were used in class, including any teaching materials developed for the classroom. This report is due **June 30 of the program year**.

If awarded the Korea from A Single Shard program, I agree to submit the implementation report as outlined above to the Outreach Coordinator at the U-M Nam Center for Korean Studies.
