 - Anticipating the camp to begin in July 25-29 (a week long day camp) for 7th and 8th grade girls
 - Students choose a "major" and take classes and research, and following a college experience
 - Pre-med, robotics and physical sciences are the "majors" this year
 - ~20 students per class
 - Anyone from the committee interested in running a class (lesson plans can be pre-written if don't want to write yourself), experiments
 - Most interested in expanding options and showing breadth within science
 - Can offer wages to grad students interested in conducting complicated lessons
