Teaching credit for each course follows the formula above, and is divided between instructors.

## Effort

Faculty with 100% appointments are expected to teach at least 2 undergraduate and 1 graduate courses each year, plus work on independent study courses (e.g., 619, 995, 326, 424) with 10 graduates and undergraduates enrolled per year. 75% appointments teach 2 courses per year, 50% teach 3 courses over two years, and 25% teach 3 courses over four years. All faculty must teach at least one course annually with at least 30 students (over the longer period for 50-25% appointments).
