

INTERGROUP RELATIONS

This Curriculum Guide is **not** a major or minor plan; it is a list of recommended courses for students interested in social work, law, medicine, clinical psychology, education, business and other socially diverse workplaces. Courses are related to social diversity and social justice and can help students refine and actualize their own values as persons, family members, and community members.

Note on Pre-requisites: Many of these courses have pre-requisites. Please refer to the current LSA Course Guide for information regarding which courses are required. It is important that pre-requisites are taken early in a student's academic career so that they will be completed in time to take the desired course.

All of the Psychology courses below are included in the Psychology major plan. Courses in italics are also included in the Biopsychology, Cognition and Neuroscience major plan. To determine which requirement a course fulfills, view the major worksheets at www.myumi.ch/6OvRe.
