3. How do the authors each frame their artifacts? Where does the reflective/contextual material show up in relationship to the artifacts? Do you see rough drafts? If so, where? What kind of audiences do those choices appeal to? Why do you think that?
4. Which ePortfolios do you think demonstrate the most effective overall cohesion and clarity of argument, reflection, navigation, and use of visuals? Why?
