- 1) **A statement of your research project (up to 1000 words).** The narrative should include your research question and goal, your methodology (how you plan to carry out your research), the project's significance (how it contributes to broader anthropological understandings), and the impact on your own educational process (for example, is the proposal solely independent research, research for your Honors Thesis, presentation of a paper at a major professional meeting, etc.). Include a timeline for when the research will be carried out.
- 2) **A budget.** This should include the expenses necessary to cover your research and the amount you are requesting from Anthropology. It should also include sources of funding you have already secured and other sources to which you are applying. Include your plan should additional funding not materialize.
- 3) **A letter of recommendation.** The letter should be from a faculty member familiar with your research—due 10/18/19 and 3/18/20.
