Project-based, hands-on learning of Archaeological Field Methods and a real research project studying the 1780s-1813 River Raisin settlement, under present-day Monroe, 40 minutes south of Ann Arbor or Dearborn. Expect to get dirty!

A key War of 1812 battlefield & home to a multiethnic community including French and Indigenous peoples, the site also structured Native-US relations for a century.
