The largest and most significant collection is the recently received Ani an George Bournoutian Collection, consisting of nearly 2,500 titles. The library also contains several significant collections of personal papers, including those of the late Avedis Derounian (aka John Roy Carlson), which has become a substantial source of information for researchers. Another smaller but significant collection is that of Rev. Charles A. Vertanes (1905-75), who was the director of the Armenian National Council of America in the 1940s and 1950s and was the editor of the short-lived journal Armenian Affairs.
