

Approval Process for Transfer and Study Abroad Credits

Effective fall 2018, students may receive up to a <u>maximum of 10</u> faculty-approved credits completed at another institution, either inside or outside the United States.

BEFORE taking transfer/study abroad course

- . Will course transfer to University of Michigan?
 - a) YES Course is listed on Transfer Equivalencies (TCE) webpage: http://www.ugadmiss.umich.edu/TCE/Public/CT_TCESearch.aspx
 - b) Course **NOT** listed on TCE webpage above. Submit for evaluation at: <u>https://www.ugadmiss.umich.edu/TCE/Student/CT_TCEForm.aspx</u>
- 2. Will course count toward Communication and Media major?
 - a) <u>Domestic Transfer Credit</u> Make appointment with Communication and Media faculty advisor for review of course description and syllabus. Bring material/documentation about the program/courses, including syllabi.
 - b) Foreign Transfer (study abroad) credit

 Complete the Communication and Media pre-approval Qualtrics form (<u>http://bit.ly/1xKHkoz</u>) for evaluation of study abroad courses to count toward your major. (You will need the course syllabus (previous syllabus for <u>same</u> class acceptable) to upload to the pre-approval site.)

AFTER completing pre-approved transfer/study abroad course

3. Has course posted on University of Michigan transcript?

Have transfer/study abroad institution send transcript to University of Michigan, Office of Undergraduate Admissions, 1220 SAB, 515 E. Jefferson, Ann Arbor, MI 48109-1316. **Posting can take 8-12 weeks!**

4. Has course been finalized to count toward Communication and Media major?

Once grades have posted on your transcript please email <u>commadvisor@umich.edu</u>, so that we can apply the courses to the major requirements.

Please Note:

- Transfer/study abroad credit posted on UM transcript by Undergraduate Admissions or courses listed on TCE web page are NOT
 automatically approved credit toward the major.
- Evaluation of *credit toward the major* can only take place by following the steps noted above.
- Approved coursework not counted toward major or minor may be used toward 120 general credits for graduation or for distribution (if approved by a general advisor in the Newnan Advising Center).
