
UNDERGRADUATE FALL AWARDS

Ann Arbor News Scholarship

Established in 1967 with a gift from the Ann Arbor News, this annual scholarship will be awarded to undergraduate or graduate students active in Communication Studies, with a preference for students who intend to enter the newspaper field. (Application required. Award up to \$3,000.)

John L. and Clara M. Brumm Memorial Scholarship

An outgrowth of a contribution by the Michigan Interscholastic Press Association, this scholarship was named in honor of the organization's founder and director. The award is given in recognition of outstanding academic performance to undergraduate or graduate students active in Communication Studies. (Application required. Award up to \$2,000 to a continuing student, with financial need also considered.)

The James P. Chapman Memorial Scholarship

Established in 1998 by CARA charities, this award honors the memory of James P. Chapman. During his long career as a journalist and publicist on the auto racing scene, Mr. Chapman was an instrumental supporter of CARA Charities and its work, helping families and children's charities across the country. This scholarship will be awarded to undergraduate or graduate students active in Communication Studies. (Application required. Award up to \$1,000)

Carole Simpson Minority Aid Scholarship

Established in 1992 by Emmy Award-winning senior correspondent for ABC News, Carole Simpson, the money was given for scholarships for minority students active in Communication Studies. This annual scholarship will be awarded to undergraduate or graduate students active in Communication Studies. (Application required. Award up to \$1,500.)

Leland Stowe Award

Established in 1981 by Leland and Theodora Stowe, this annual scholarship is given to undergraduate students active in Communication Studies, with a preference for individuals seeking a career in print communication and who have displayed academic excellence. (Application required. Award up to \$2,000 to a continuing student, financial need also considered.)

***Note: Any student who has received a particular award may not receive that award again.
Priority for all awards will be given to students who have not already received an award.***

Applicants must be declared Communication Studies majors with at least junior standing.

All applications must be submitted with the following documentation:

- One to two page personal essay discussing educational achievements and career aspirations
- One letter of recommendation from a faculty member or GSI of the Department of Communication Studies (Only one letter of recommendation is required if applying for more than one award.)
