

Embedded Master's (MA) Guide sheet for non-Econ PhD Students

Students from other non-Economics PhD programs are welcome to apply for a Masters of Arts (MA) in Economics. This is typically a degree embedded within the Economics PhD program. The degree requires a certain set of coursework to be completed prior to obtaining the MA in Economics.

The following courses are required:

- Microeconomic Theory (with a grade of B- or better)
 - Econ 601
 - Econ 602
 - Econ 603
 - Econ 604
- Macroeconomic Theory (with a grade of B- or better)
 - Econ 605
 - Econ 607
- Mathematics and Econometrics (with a grade of B or better)
 - Econ 600
 - Econ 671
 - Econ 672
- Cognate courses
 - 4 credit hours from your home department/program
- Economics Field Courses
 - Two field courses in Economics
 - Two in a sequence, or one in two distinct fields

If you have completed these items, you will need to complete the following:

1. Email Hiba Baghdadi (PhD Coordinator for Economics) to begin the process
2. Complete the [Add a Degree or Certificate Program Application](#)
3. Have your Program Director or Director of Graduate Studies sign the form
4. Turn into Hiba at the Economics Department

Once all items are completed and your application is approved by the Director of Graduate Studies at the Department of Economics, we will be able to send it to the Rackham Graduate School and approve the MA degree in Economics.
