

Request for Graduate Research Supplies

Any expenditure made without prior approval and without the faculty (thesis) advisor's support may not be approved. A brief description of the research project and the proposed research expenditures should be supplied below.

Requests for supplies that will directly be used in the execution of laboratory and/or field research are typically accepted. Note, requests for clothing, footwear, hats, gloves, sunblock, books, costs associated with publication and purchase of reprints, will not be approved.
