

English Honors Major Checklist

Prerequisite and Declaration Process:

- English 298 must be completed with a grade of C- or higher prior to declaration.
- English 298 **does not** count toward the 30 credits required for the major.
- Students must declare with an English advisor. Advising appointments are scheduled on the English website.

Declaration Prerequisite: English 298 – Introduction to Literary Studies

Time Period / Subject Requirements

Time Period Requirement: Three **separate** time-period courses are required. One course **must** be a course in Pre-1642 literature and one course **must** be a course in Pre-1830 literature. The final course can be any combination of an additional Pre-1642 or Pre-1830 or a course designated as Pre-1900.

Subject Requirements: When specific courses are designated as satisfying multiple Time Period and Subject Requirements, English majors have the option of using a single course to satisfy a maximum of **two** requirements, though the credits will only count once toward the required 30 credits. 200-level courses cannot be used toward Time Period and Subject requirements.

Additional Honors Requirements: Honors students are required to take one course in Theory (390 or 490); an Honors Junior Seminar; and two Thesis courses. Where appropriate, the theory course and the honors junior seminar may also satisfy a subject or time period requirement and so could be counted across two requirements, though the credits would only count once toward the required 30 credits.

English majors may take two 200-level courses and two 300/400-level creative/expository writing courses as elective credits (from the lists below). Any other 300- or 400-level English Literature course will also count as an elective course.

Additional Information

- All courses counted toward the major must be completed with a grade of C- or better.
- Students must maintain a 2.0 GPA in the major.
- ALA 325 Putting Your Education to Work: can now be counted toward elective English credits (1 credit).
- Two 200-level courses may be used toward elective credits (no more than 6 credits). 200-level courses will **not** count toward the Core Requirements. Eligible courses include:
