Prerequisite and Declaration Process:

- English 298 must be completed with a grade of C- or higher prior to declaration.
- English 298 **does not** count toward the 30 credits required for the major.
- Students must declare with an English advisor. Advising appointments are scheduled on the English website.

Core Requirements: When a single class is designated as satisfying more than one requirement, that single class may be used for two requirements, though the course credits will only count once. 200-level courses **may not** be used toward these requirements. Three time-period courses are required; one course **must** be a course in Pre-1642 literature and one course **must** be in Pre-1830 literature.

Additional Information

- All courses counted toward the major must be completed with a grade of C- or better.
- Students must maintain a 2.0 GPA in the major.
- Two creative/expository writing courses may be counted toward the English Major. English 323, 324, 325, 327, 328, 423, 424, 425, 426, 427, or any transferred writing course. This also includes WRITING 300.
- Two 200-level courses may be used toward elective credits (no more than 6 credits). 200-level courses will **not** count toward the Core Requirements. Eligible courses are: 201, 203, 215, 216, 221, 230, 232, 235, 240, 242, 245, 250, 258, 260, 267, 270, 274, 275, 280, 282, 285, 290, 292, 293
- Students should consult with an English advisor at least once a year.
