

English Creative Writing Sub-concentration Checklist

Prerequisite and Declaration Process:

- English 223 and 298 must be completed with a grade of C- or higher prior to declaration.
- English 223 and 298 **do not** count toward the 30 credits required for the major.
- Students must apply to the Creative Writing Sub-concentration.

Time Period / Subject Requirements

Time Period Requirement: Three **separate** time-period courses are required. One course **must** be a course in Pre-1642 literature and one course **must** be a course in Pre-1830 literature. The final course can be any combination of an additional Pre-1642 or Pre-1830 or a course designated as Pre-1900.

Subject Requirements: When specific courses are designated as satisfying multiple Time Period and Subject Requirements, English majors have the option of using a single course to satisfy a maximum of **two** requirements, though the credits will only count once toward the required 30 credits. 200-level courses cannot be used toward Time Period and Subject requirements.

Additional Sub-concentration Requirements – Creative Writing Courses: The Creative Writing Sub-concentrator takes two courses in a selected track (Fiction or Poetry), and all sub-concentrators take English 428 in their final semester. Sub-concentrators may take a third creative writing course that is outside their track and may count that additional course toward elective English credits.
