

## Requirements for a German Minor

**PREREQUISITES:** German 101, 102, and 231 or the equivalent, as determined by the departmental placement examination. Credits obtained through retroactive credits (232 or higher) or AP/IB credits (232 or higher) will not count towards the minor.

**REQUIREMENTS:** No less than 18 hours at the level of German 232 or higher. The Conversation courses (306) will count towards a minor if the class is graded (Winter 2014 and later). Students must take either German 325 or 326. Either 325 or 326 may be repeated one time, provided the content is different. At least four courses counting towards the 18-hour total must be taught in German, and at least one must be numbered 400 or above. Students are strongly encouraged to give further coherence to their programs by electing courses within the same "German Studies sequence".

**INTERNSHIPS:** If students complete a summer-internship program in Germany, Switzerland or Austria, and enroll in German 351 (1-3 credits) the following Fall, the credits will count towards the minor.

**STUDY ABROAD:** If students study abroad through a program affiliated with the University of Michigan (Academic Year in Freiburg, Winter term in Tübingen), the credits will count provided that the classes are taught in German. For all other students: at least 10 credits for the minor must be taken as regular University of Michigan credits.

**German Minor Requirements: German 230, 232, or RCLANG 291:**

A total of **18 CREDITS** at the level German 232 or higher must be taken for the German minor. Four courses must be taught in German. AP/IB Credit or Retroactive Credits do not count towards the German minor.

Only FOUR credits of RCLANG 291 (German 230) count towards the German minor.

AP/IB Credits or Retroactive Credits for German 232 **CANNOT** be used here. If you have German 232 AP/IB or Retroactive Credits, all credits for the German minor must come from classes numbered German 243 or higher.
