#### “Educating Hearts as Well as Minds”

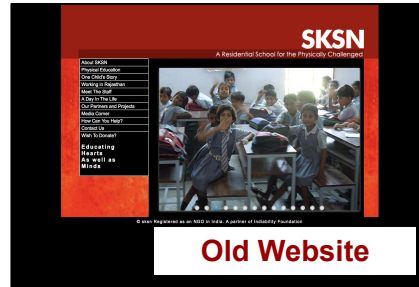
SKSN is an NGO that has provided education for low-income and physically disabled children in Rajasthan since 1991. Currently, it is a boarding school for both disabled and able-bodied students, that offers full curriculums for children aged 4 to 18. Their students are both eligible and encouraged to take the national exams in grades 10 and 12. SKSN’s belief is that everyone is entitled to an education, regardless of their ability, gender, race, or caste.

Our goal was to transition the 2006 website into a more mobile- and user-friendly webpage. We split into two teams: one to rewrite the website code, the other to edit website content.

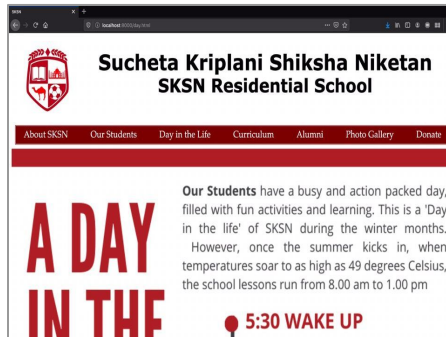
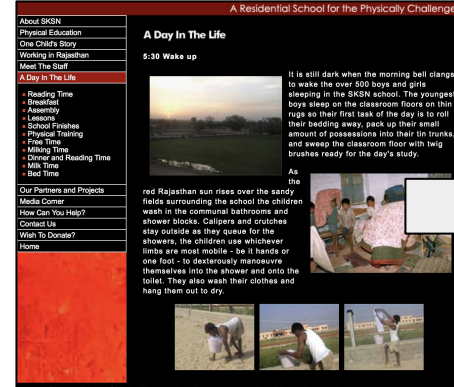


Old Website

## A DAY IN THE LIFE

Our Students have a busy and action packed day, filled with fun activities and learning. This is a 'Day in the life' of SKSN during the winter months. However, once the summer kicks in when temperatures soar to as high as 49 degrees Celsius, the school lessons run from 8.00 am to 1.00 pm

- 5:30 WAKE UP**  
It is still dark when the morning bell clangs to wake up the boys and girls sleeping in the SKSN school
- 7:30 READING TIME**  
The students spend two hours studying their school exercise and doing their homework.
- 9:30 BREAKFAST**  
The boys and girls eat breakfast in their own dining halls. Often they eat from the vegetables grown in our own fields!
- 10:15 LESSONS**  
Teaching takes place for 6 hours a day, consisting of 8 periods of 40 minutes each.
- 16:00 SCHOOL ENDS**  
The children change out of their school uniform, pack away their exercise books and a light meal of fruit, rice and vegetables is taken
- 18:00 FREE TIME**  
The children now have time to play! Students may be seen playing sports, watching a tape, or dancing!
- 19:00 DINNER**  
Students again covein in their respective dining halls. Dinner usually consists of Daal, seasonal vegetables, roti and rice
- 21:30 MILK TIME**  
Since the children have been able to have milk and ghee it has reduced sickness in the school. For new students, this has helped them return to good health
- 22:00 BEDTIME**  
The children go to bed, tired out from a full day of activity. The school slogan, 'Educating Hearts as well as Minds' has been achieved for another day.
