This sandal is a toddler size 9.5. It is made of palm fiber.

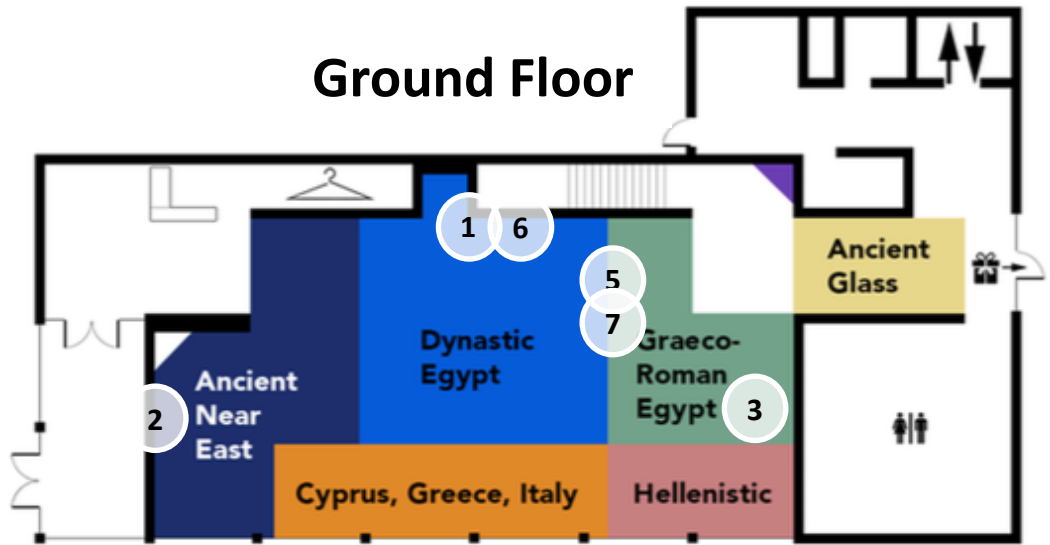


Dog figurine made of clay.
