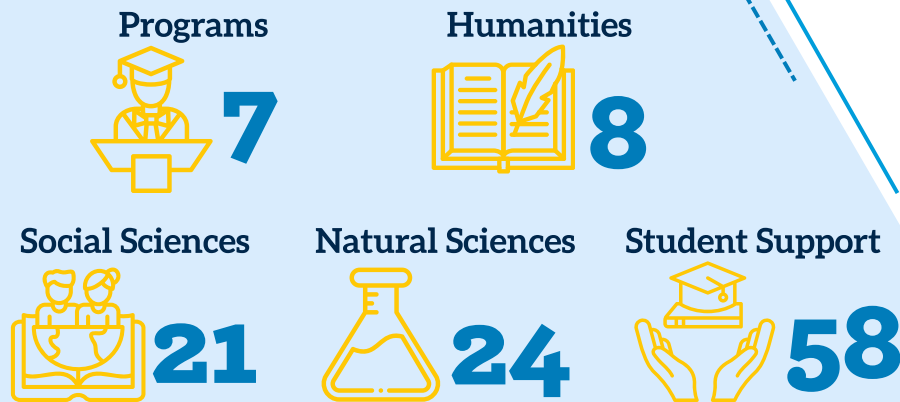


Thank You Legacy Match Donors!

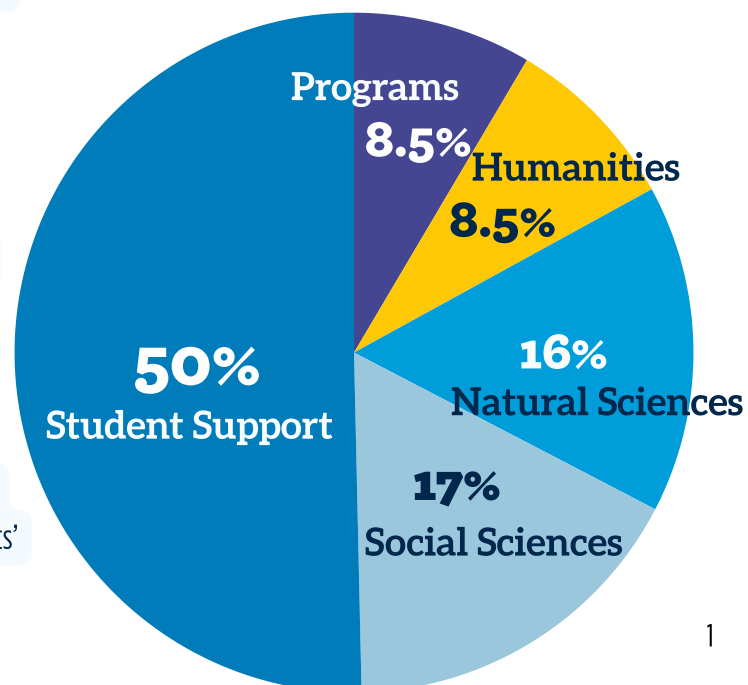

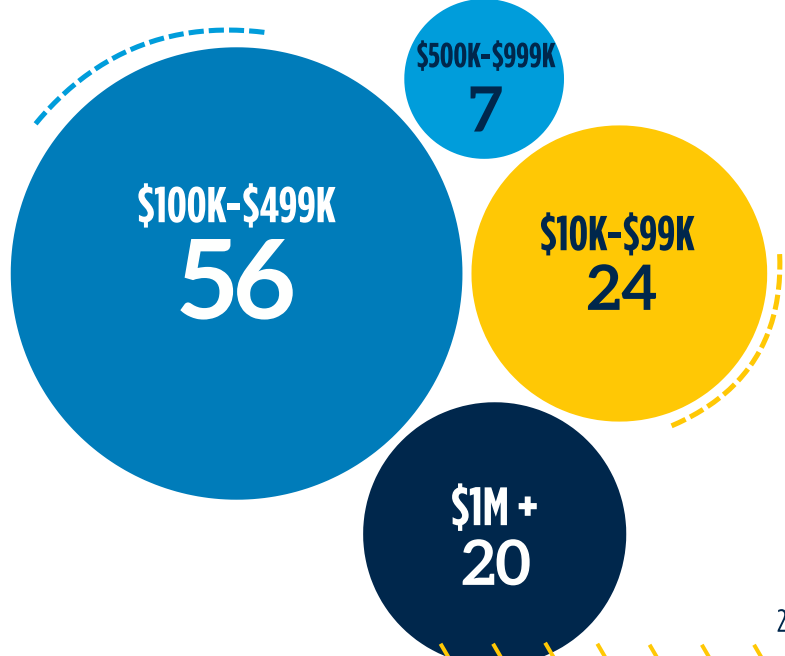
