HSSP students live together in an environment focused on supporting their journey as first-year college students at the University of Michigan. The program supports students' academic and social well-being, and introduces them to university resources and opportunities.

The transition to college at U-M can be thrilling. It can be daunting as well, especially for students who are the first in their families to attend college. For students considering paths in medicine and healthcare, it may be especially so. Many students who dream of a medical career find themselves challenged as never before by pre-health coursework. Others long imagined themselves as doctors but question this path when they learn about public health and the myriad other ways to “do” healthcare work.

Students take courses together on healthcare systems and professions. They benefit from study groups, dedicated academic and pre-health advising, and are mentored by student peers. They shadow healthcare professionals and see firsthand the ways that medicine is a team sport. With all the programming elements taken together, HSSP inspires, fosters confidence, belonging, purpose, and life-long friendships.

HSSP now offers a non-residential program for transfer students, dedicated to supporting the unique needs of students coming from community colleges and other institutions.
