### **A Resolution Allocating \$300 to LSA Facilities to Install two Goose-neck Attachments in the Undergraduate Sciences Building**

*A bill for the consideration of the College of Literature, Science, and the Arts Student Government*

**Whereas**, the mission of the College of Literature, Science, and the Arts Student Government (hereafter LSA SG) is to “actively seek the voices of LSA students and advocate their interests to improve academic and non-academic life”;<sup>1</sup> and,

**Whereas**, as the voice of the students, and with climate change being a major concern amongst Literature, Sciences, and the Arts (hereafter LSA) students on campus, LSA SG seeks to increase campus sustainability; and,

**Whereas**, the Office of Campus Sustainability has previously installed numerous water refill stations across campus to reduce waste and increase easy access to water<sup>2</sup>; and,

**Whereas**, water refill stations provide a practical alternative to plastic water bottles, thus reducing both the University of Michigan’s Waste Factor and Carbon Footprint; and,

**Whereas**, although there are over 250 water refill stations on campus, many academic buildings with high student foot traffic do not have them<sup>3</sup>; and,

**Whereas**, Central Student Government previously passed Assembly Resolution 5-013, which voices support and allocates funds for the implementation of water refill stations; and,

**Whereas**, the Undergraduate Science Building (hereafter USB) currently has no water refill stations; and,

**Whereas**, LSA Facilities has promised funding for the labor of installing water refill stations around campus, including in the USB; and,

**Whereas**, LSA SG seeks to alleviate the costs associated with the parts for this project.

**Be it therefore resolved**, LSA SG shall help fund this project by allocating \$300 from the Individual Projects Fund of the General Fund to USB Facilities; and,

**Be it finally resolved**, LSA SG shall continue to support and advocate for sustainable practices, including the installation of more water refill stations, across campus.
