**A Resolution to Sponsor the Hydration Station Initiative**

*A bill for the consideration of the College of Literature, Science, and the Arts Student Government*

**Whereas**, the mission of the College of Literature, Science, and the Arts Student Government (hereafter LSA SG) is to “actively seek the voices of LSA students and advocate their interests to improve academic and non-academic life”;<sup>1</sup> and,

**Whereas**, football Saturdays, including the tailgates and other festivities surrounding them, are a major component of student life at the University of Michigan; and,

**Whereas**, the University of Michigan 2016 football schedule has five back-to-back home games to start the season<sup>2</sup>; and,

**Whereas**, dehydration is a major student health, safety, and well-being concern on football Saturdays; and,

**Whereas**, the Central Student Government (hereafter CSG), the Interfraternity Council (hereafter IFC), and the Panhellenic Association (hereafter Panhel) have a Hydration Station Initiative to “establish free hydration stations in high-risk areas on the way to Michigan Stadium, including on Hill, Packard, and South State Streets” to combat dehydration on football Saturdays<sup>3</sup>; and,

**Whereas**, CSG, IFC, and Panhel are looking for partners to assist with their Hydration Station Initiative and directly reached out to collaborate with LSA SG.

**Be it therefore resolved**, LSA SG shall contribute \$500 from the General Fund for this event; and,

**Be it finally resolved**, LSA SG will be recognized as a sponsor of this event and shall be listed as such.
