An Amendment to the Eleventh Chapter of the Bylaws Expanding the Duties of the Health Subcommittee

A bill for the consideration of the College of Literature, Science, and the Arts Student Government

Whereas, the mission of the College of Literature, Science, and the Arts Student Government (hereafter LSA SG) is to “actively seek the voices of LSA students and advocate their interests to improve academic and non-academic life”;¹ and,

Whereas, LSA SG utilizes its Bylaws to structure and facilitate official business, and recognizes the need for amendments to the Bylaws to improve its function and reflect current practices; and,

Whereas, the Health Subcommittee (hereafter Health) works “to improve the general quality of health, both physical and mental, for students of the University”;² and,

Whereas, it is the opinion of Health leadership that Health may better serve LSA students by broadening its purposes as enumerated in the Bylaws.

Be it therefore resolved, that the Bylaws be amended in accordance with the language in Appendix A; and;

Be it further resolved, that these changes take immediate effect; and,

Be it finally resolved, that LSA SG expresses its gratitude to Health for their work in advocating for students’ wellbeing all throughout the COVID-19 pandemic.

Appendix A

Health Subcommittee

11.02.00 **Purpose.** The Health Subcommittee of the Student Life Committee (hereafter Health) shall work *to improve the general quality of health, encompassing but not limited to physical, mental, emotional, and social, for students of the College of Literature, Science, and the Arts.* ~~*to improve the general quality of health, both physical and mental, for students of the University.*~~

11.02.01 **Improvement of Well-Being.** Health shall be charged with working on at least two improvements to the general well-being of LSA students each semester. The body will take into consideration concerns raised by Committee members, government members, and any constituents present.

11.02.03 **Cooperation.** Health shall work with staff and administrators throughout the University including but not limited to SAPAC, CAPS, and UHS in order to address student and University health needs and to raise awareness of various health related issues, problems, and crises.
