10 11 12 13 14	Whereas, the mission of the College of Literature, Science, and the Arts Student Government (hereafter LSA SG) is to "actively seek the voices of students within the College of Literature, Science, and the Arts (hereafter LSA) and advocate their interests to improve academic and non-academic life"; and,
15 16 17 18	<b>Whereas,</b> Services for Students with Disabilities (hereafter SSD) provides student accommodations at the University and receives a growing number of students each year, with the number of applications reaching a record number of 1,071 in the 2014-2015 academic year; and,
19 20	Whereas, the large majority of students who apply to SSD are students in LSA; and,
21 22 23 24	<b>Whereas</b> , the current Testing Accommodation Center in the Modern Languages Building has only 45 seats and cannot adequately accommodate the majority of students who require it, especially during midterms and finals; and,
<ul><li>25</li><li>26</li><li>27</li><li>28</li></ul>	<b>Whereas,</b> LSA SG received complaints directly from students in the form of emails regarding the Testing Accommodation Center; and,
29 30 31	Whereas, professors currently hold the legal responsibility of finding accommodations for their students, often leading to insufficient accommodations due to lack of adequate space provided by the University; and,
32 33 34 35	<b>Whereas</b> , the space limitation places pressure on professors to create sufficient accommodations when none are available, creating a difficult situation for both professors and students.
36 37 38	<b>Be it therefore resolved,</b> LSA SG formally supports the building of an improved Testing Accommodation Center, which reflects the growing number of SSD applicants, and provides additional private rooms and a reception area to minimize external distractions; and,
<ul><li>39</li><li>40</li><li>41</li></ul>	<b>Be it further resolved</b> , this Testing Accommodation Center should be available to all LSA students as well as students from other colleges taking an LSA course; and,
42 43 44	<b>Be it finally resolved,</b> LSA SG plans to work in collaboration with Central Student Government to expand this initiative to all schools and colleges.
