11	Whereas, the mission of the College of Literature, Science, and the Arts Student Government
12 13	(hereafter LSA SG) is to "actively seek the voices of LSA students and advocate their interests to improve academic and non- academic life"; and,

15 16	Whereas, LSA SG has received numerous complaints regarding the dirty and potentially infectious keyboards of the computers in the Shapiro Undergraduate Library (hereafter UGLi); and,

19	Whereas, LSA SG recognizes the health concerns of students, especially during the winter
20 21	months, when diseases and illnesses have been shown to spread more easily; and,
22	Whereas, the UGLi is a communal facility frequented by students to study and convene with
23 24	friends; and,
25	Whereas, the spread of diseases and illnesses amongst students can be deterred by sanitizing the
26	keyboards within the UGLi thoroughly; and,
27 28	Whereas, LSA SG receives \$1.50 from every student enrolled in the College of Literature,
29	Science, and the Arts; and,
30	Serence, and the Firm, and,
31	Whereas, the money received from the students should be used to help improve their academic
32	and non- academic life.
33 34	Be it therefore resolved, LSA SG formally supports up to a \$500 payment to the UGLi facilities
35	to cover the cost of the expenses necessary to adequately and more routinely disinfect the
36	keyboards within the UGLi; and,

38	Be it therefore resolved, this payment shall be used to supply at least one sanitary wipe
39	dispenser and the wipes themselves that students can use to clean the keyboards; and,
40	Be it finally resolved, the Treasurer of LSA SG will immediately move to transfer the funds to
