R W2016.07 A Resolution Requesting that the City of Ann Arbor Investigate the Population of Corvus brachyrhynchos On and Near the University of Michigan - Ann Arbor Campus A bill for the consideration of the College of Literature, Science, and the Arts Student Government 24 February 2016 Sponsors: Ryan Gillcrist, Nicholas Fadanelli, Patrick Miller, Elaina Rahrig Whereas, the mission of the College of Literature, Science, and the Arts Student Government (hereafter LSA SG) is to "actively seek the voices of LSA students and advocate their interests to improve academic and non-academic life"; and, Whereas, the environment around campus, including the wildlife populations that inhabit it, have an impact on student life on and near campus; and, Whereas, in the past there have been negative incidents with wildlife on campus; and, Whereas, there have been numerous complaints about the population of various avian species on and near campus, particularly Corvus brachyrhynchos; and, Whereas, it is outside the realm of student government of any level to regulate wildlife on and off a college campus; and, Whereas, if there is an issue with avian populations on and near the campus, it would affect both University of Michigan students and other Ann Arbor residents; and, Whereas, this issue falls solely under the jurisdiction of the City of Ann Arbor. Be it therefore resolved, LSA SG formally requests that the City of Ann Arbor investigate avian populations on and off the University of Michigan - Ann Arbor campus, especially that of Corvus brachyrhynchos; and, Be it further resolved, the sponsors of this resolution will work in association with the Central Student Government and Engineering Student Government to pass a similar resolutions through their legislative assemblies; and, Be it further resolved, LSA SG shall work with the City of Ann Arbor if the City of Ann Arbor finds that there is a problem with avian populations on and near campus and requests the assistance of LSA SG; and. Be it finally resolved, LSA SG will send a copy of this resolution and a signed letter of support, written by the LSA SG Executive Board in consultation with the sponsors, to City of Ann Arbor Mayor Christopher Taylor, the Ann Arbor City Council, University of Michigan President Mark Schlissel, and to Head of Facilities Doug Johnston.
