A Resolution Recommending the Installation of Informational Plaques in Named University Buildings

A bill for the consideration of the College of Literature, Science, and the Arts Student Government

Whereas, the mission of the College of Literature, Science, and the Arts Student Government (hereafter LSA SG) is to "actively seek the voices of LSA students and advocate their interests to improve academic and non-academic life"; and,

Whereas, the University of Michigan has a long tradition of naming buildings after former presidents, prominent former administrators and faculty, and individuals whose financial contributions have significantly impacted the University; and,

Whereas, students' nonacademic life is enriched through knowledge of the long, proud, and rich history and tradition of the University of Michigan; and,

Whereas, the University of Michigan in 2017 will be celebrating its bicentennial and consequently be promoting and working to actively further the public history of the University through various projects and events; and,

Whereas, currently the vast majority of named buildings do not provide a sufficient explanation of who and why they are named as is; and,

Whereas, informational plaques detailing the history and reasons behind the name and naming of named buildings on campus would not only be a very valuable project to enhance the University's bicentennial efforts, but also improve students' knowledge about the University, and hopefully spark campus dialogue about building names and contributions of past individuals to the University.

Be it therefore resolved, LSA SG recommends the installation of informational plaques about the namesake of named University Buildings, describing, amongst other things, the relation of the namesake to the building and the University and why the building bears the name of the namesake; and,

Be it further resolved, the sponsors of this resolution will work in conjunction with the Bicentennial Planning Office, the Bentley Historical Library, and Facilities and Operations to begin discussions about how to best implement this project for currently existing and future existing buildings; and,

Be it further resolved, LSA SG shall work to advocate for LSA students, faculty, and administrators in any future discussions regarding the naming of future campus buildings; and,
