11 12 13 14	<b>Whereas,</b> the mission of the College of Literature, Science, and the Arts Student Government (hereafter LSA SG) is to "actively seek the voices of LSA students and advocate their interests to improve academic and non- academic life"; and,
16 17 18	<b>Whereas,</b> sustainability and conservation awareness continue to be prevalent issues around the world and on the University of Michigan's Ann Arbor campus; and,
19 20 21	<b>Whereas</b> , it is our responsibility as the governing body of the College of LSA to ensure that we are doing our part to reduce our ecological footprint; and,
22 23 24	Whereas, due to lack of knowledge, items that can be recycled often end up in the trash or items that cannot be recycled contaminate recycling streams; and,
25 26 27	<b>Whereas,</b> LSA SG holds and provides funding for numerous events throughout the year that use copious amounts of disposable cutlery, generate lots of food waste, and result in the disposal of many other items; and,
28 29 30	<b>Whereas,</b> many Budget Allocation Committee (hereafter BAC) applications contain sections for funding involving the serving of food; and,
31 32 33 34	<b>Whereas</b> , there are <u>grants</u> from the Student Sustainability Initiative (hereafter SSI) at the University of Michigan and <u>programs</u> from Planet Blue that provide funding and infrastructure for zero waste events.
35 36 37	<b>Be it therefore resolved,</b> LSA SG will take sustainability into account when holding internal events, external events, and when allocating funding; and,
38 39 10	<b>Be it further resolved,</b> LSA SG will seek out and encourage zero waste events from SSI grants and Planet Blue programs for internal, external, and funded events; and,
11 12	<b>Be it further resolved,</b> when not feasible, LSA SG and will seek out and encourage other ways to reduce, reuse, and recycle waste, especially for events that involve the serving of food; and,
13 14 15 16	<b>Be it finally resolved,</b> LSA SG's Taking Responsibility for the Earth and Environment Subcommittee will create a guide to reduce waste for events that will be made available to all on the LSA SG website and will be sent to all BAC applicants when applicable.
