**A Resolution to Create a “Before I die…” Wall in Angell Hall**

*A bill for the consideration of the College of Literature, Science, and the Arts Student Government*

**Whereas**, the mission of the College of Literature, Science, and the Arts Student Government (hereafter LSA SG) is to “actively seek the voices of LSA students and advocate their interests to improve academic and non-academic life”;<sup>1</sup> and,

**Whereas**, mental health is a growing issue on campus that needs to be addressed; and,

**Whereas**, a “Before I die…” Wall is a large chalk wall with blank lines for students to write hopes, dreams, and goals to complete the sentence “Before I die…”; and,

**Whereas**, *Before I Die* is a global art project that invites people to reflect on their lives and share their personal aspirations in public space; and,

**Whereas**, artist Candy Chang created an interactive wall on an abandoned house in her neighborhood to create an anonymous place to help restore perspective and share intimately with neighbors and friends; and,

**Whereas**, this wall is meant to provide a level of motivation and well-being for students on campus; and,

**Whereas**, *Publishers Weekly* calls it, “a powerful and valuable reminder that life is for the living, and it’s never too late, or too early, to join the party”;<sup>2</sup> and,

**Whereas**, the University of Michigan works to create a community where individuals can share their experiences, stories, and goals in order to foster a more accepting and inclusive community; and,

**Whereas**, *The Atlantic* called the *Before I Die* campaign “one of the most creative community projects ever”;<sup>3</sup> and,

**Whereas**, Tulane University and University of Southern California both have “Before I die…” Walls, which have received great responses and feedback from students and faculty around campus\*\*; and,

**Whereas**, University of Michigan strives to be one of the leading universities in the country in regards to improving mental health on campus.
