A Resolution Encouraging the Release of Historic Grade Distributions for All LSA Courses

A bill for the consideration of the College of Literature, Science, and the Arts Student Government

Whereas, the mission of the College of Literature, Science, and the Arts Student Government (hereafter LSA SG) is to “actively seek the voices of LSA students and advocate their interests to improve academic and non-academic life”;¹ and,

Whereas, grade distributions from previous semesters are not published for LSA students by the University; and,

Whereas, grade distributions are a useful tool for students in planning their schedules by allowing students to balance their schedules based on difficulty as to not be overwhelmed in a single semester.

Be it therefore resolved, LSA SG encourages the addition of grade distribution data for all LSA courses to Academic Reporting Toolkit; and,

Be it finally resolved, this resolution along with a letter approved by the Executive Board will be sent to Associate Dean for Undergraduate Education Angela Dillard, Academic Reporting Toolkit Team Lead Professor August Evrard, Dean Andrew Martin, William Schultz Faculty Senate Chair.
