MINOR REQUIREMENTS

7 courses of at least three credits each

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PREREQUISITE COURSE

- ☐ Spanish 277, 278, or RCLANG 324

RCLANG 324

- Students who do not take Spanish 277:
 - First RCLANG 324 = Pre-req & 300-level elective
 - Second RCLANG 324 = 300-level elective
- Students who take Spanish 277:
 - First RCLANG 324 = 300-level elective
 - Second RCLANG 324 = 300-level elective

AP/IB Credit

- Students with AP/IB credit for Spanish 279x can count the course as a 279-399 level elective.

Meeting the Literature Requirement

- A minimum of 3 courses must be literature courses from 279-499. Literature courses also meet the minor requirements at the 279-399 or 400 levels.

Study Abroad Courses

- A pre- evaluation and final evaluation of study abroad courses are required. Make an appointment with a Spanish faculty advisor on the RLL website.

Independent Studies & Internships

- No more than one independent study and one internship (6 credits) can be counted toward the minor without approval of the Spanish UCC.

Residence Requirement

- A minimum of 4 courses of at least 3 credits each for the minor must be taken either in-residence or through a study abroad program affiliated with University of Michigan.

LSA Course Sharing Policy

- Per LSA guidelines, students are only permitted to share one course between a major and a minor.

Spanish Language, Literature, and Culture Minor

Prerequisites for the Minor

- Spanish 277 (or 278)
- The SPANISH 277 prerequisite will be waived for Residential College students who complete one RCLANG 324. RC students may use RCLANG 324 toward their Spanish major 279-399 level course requirements, including the first RCLANG 324 course used to satisfy the major's prerequisite.

Minor Requirements

- 7 courses of at least three credits each, beyond the prerequisites, including:
 - A maximum of 4 Spanish courses numbered 279-399; up to two terms of RCLANG 324 may also be used to meet this requirement.
 - A minimum of 3 Spanish courses numbered 400-499.
 - A minimum of 3 literature courses numbered 279-499. Literature courses also meet the minor requirements at either the 279-399 or 400 levels.
 - To determine if courses count as literature credit, please refer to the LSA Course Guide and/or the literature course lists on the [RLL website](#).
- No more than one independent study and one internship (6 credits) can be counted toward the minor without approval of the Spanish Undergraduate Curriculum Committee.
- It is possible to take your third 279-399 course concurrently with your first 400-level course. Students must contact rll.mailbox@umich.edu to make this request.

Residence Requirement

- A minimum of 4 courses of at least 3 credits each for the minor must be taken either in-residence or through a [study abroad program](#) affiliated with University of Michigan.

Students who wish to pursue an academic minor are strongly encouraged to make a general advising appointment to discuss degree requirements/options and to develop a plan for degree completion.
