

## Italian Minor Requirements

### Prerequisites:

ITALIAN 230, 232, 410, or the equivalent.

### Requirements:

**Minimum Credits:** 18

### Required Courses in SPANISH:

- 18 credits of courses in ITALIAN numbered ITALIAN 235 or higher, of which nine credits must be conducted in Italian language.
- Three credits may be accepted from courses in a cognate field, selected in consultation with and approved by the department advisor.

### Constraints

- The 18 credits must include at least one course at the 200-level beyond ITALIAN 233, at least one at the 300-level, and the 400-level.
- ITALIAN 410 (Italian for Spanish speakers) does not count toward the Italian requirements for the minor.

### Residency

At least 9 of the 18 credits for the Academic Minor must be taken in residence or in a study abroad program affiliated with the University of Michigan.

### Study Abroad

Study abroad courses must be evaluated by an Italian faculty advisor. Students must make an appointment prior to their departure and after their return for a pre- and post-evaluation.

### AP/IB Credit

Students with AP/IB credit for Italian can receive additional 3 credits for Italian 237x after completing one course beyond Italian 232, taught in Italian, with a grade of "B" or better. Italian 237x counts toward the Italian major or minor as an upper 200 level course.

### Teaching Certificate

Students interested in obtaining a secondary teaching certificate should study the general requirements for professional preparation, which appear under the "Teacher Certification Program" on this website.
