#### **RCLANG 324**

- Students who take Spanish 277:
  - O First RCLANG 324 = 300-level elective
  - Second RCLANG 324 = 300-level elective
  - O Third RCLANG 324 = 300-level elective

 Spanish 279x can count toward the Spanish major at the 279-399 level

#### **Cognate Course (optional)**

One cognate course may be included in the major.

#### **Study Abroad Courses**

 A pre- evaluation and final evaluation of study abroad courses is required. Make an appointment with a Spanish faculty advisor on the RLL website.

### **Independent Studies & Internships**

 No more than one independent study and one internship (6 credits) can be counted toward the major without approval of the Spanish Undergraduate Curriculum Committee.

#### **Residence Requirement**

A maximum of 5 out-of-residence (15 credits)
courses are permitted. All other courses/credits
must be in-residence: taken on UM campus or with a
study abroad program affiliated with UM (CGIS).

# **Prerequisites for the Major**

- Spanish 277, 278, or RCLANG 324
- The SPANISH 277 prerequisite will be waived for Residential College students who complete one RCLANG 324. RC students may use RCLANG 324 toward their Spanish major 279-399 level course requirements, including the first RCLANG 324 course used to satisfy the major's prerequisite.
- Please review the Language Placement tab on the RLL website for further information about <u>RC</u> equivalencies.

### **Major Requirements**

- 10 courses of at least three credits each, beyond the prerequisites, including:
  - A maximum of 5 Spanish courses numbered 279-399. Up to three terms of RCLANG 324 may also be used to meet this requirement
  - A minimum of 5 Spanish courses numbered 400-499.
- One cognate course (3 credits) may be counted toward the Spanish major. Please see the RLL website for a list of approved <u>cognate courses</u>.
- No more than one independent study and one internship (6 credits) can be counted toward the major without approval of the Spanish Undergraduate Curriculum Committee.
- It is possible to take your third 279-399 course concurrently with your first 400-level course. Students must contact <a href="mailbox@umich.edu">rll.mailbox@umich.edu</a> to make this request.

#### **Residence Requirement**

A maximum of 5 out-of-residence courses, including test credit (AP or IB), are permitted. All other courses/credits must be in-residence: taken on UM campus or with a <u>study abroad program</u> affiliated with UM (CGIS).

Students who wish to pursue an academic major are strongly encouraged to make a general advising appointment to discuss degree requirements/options and to develop a plan for degree completion. Appointments may be scheduled on the <a href="RLL website">RLL website</a>.
