

Spanish Minor Requirements

Prerequisites:

SPANISH 277. For eligible students, SPANISH 278, Spanish for Heritage Language Learners, can be substituted for SPANISH 277.

Requirements:

Minimum Credits: 21

A minimum of 7 courses (21 approved credits), of at least 3 credits each, beyond the prerequisite.

Required Courses in SPANISH:

- 4 courses of at least 3 credits each from SPANISH courses numbered 279 to 399; up to two terms of RCLANG 324 may also be used to meet this requirement
- 3 courses of at least 3 credits each from SPANISH courses at the 400-level

Students should consult a department advisor and develop a balanced program of study that includes the cultural production of various countries and historical periods.

Constraints

- Specific course selections must include three literature courses from 279-499. Literature courses also must meet the minor requirements at the 279-399 or 400 levels.
 - To determine if courses count as a literature credit, please refer to the LSA Course Guide and/or the literature course lists on the [RLL website](#).
- Other courses, or “electives in Spanish,” may be selected in Hispanic culture, linguistics, and film.
- No more than one Independent Study and one internship course (6 credits) can be included in the major/minor.
- Each course counted toward the minor must be at least 3 credits.
- Students may count only one of ITALIAN 410 or PORTUG 280 toward the Spanish minor.

Residency

A minimum of 4 courses of at least 3 credits each for the minor must be taken either in residence or through a study-abroad program affiliated with the University of Michigan.

Study Abroad

Study abroad courses must be evaluated by a Spanish faculty advisor. Students must make an appointment prior to their departure and after their return for a pre- and post-evaluation.

AP/IB Credit

AP or IB Spanish language credit for Spanish 279x may replace a 279-399 level elective. Students with AP literature credit may also use Spanish 294x as a 279-399 level literature course. Details are available on [RLL's AP/IB webpage](#)

RC Courses

Spanish minors may take RCLANG 324 up to two times. The first RCLANG 324 replaces 277/278 and counts as a 279-399 level elective. Review RLL's [RC equivalency page](#) for additional information.
