

Follow all directions.

Submit your application to socadvisor@umich.edu no later than 5pm on Friday, October 26, 2018.

Compose an email to socadvisor@umich.edu that includes:

1. your name
2. UM-ID
3. unickname
4. preferred email address

Attach a statement of intent and a writing sample the email as two separate documents in **.pdf format** using the titling convention examples described below.

STATEMENT OF INTENT

- Write a well-organized statement discussing your ideas for a thesis project and your perspective on how the Honors Program in Sociology fits into your future plans as a scholar or professional.
- Your statement should be two to three pages and must be a typed double-spaced document with margins no smaller than one inch.
- Name your statement of intent document *LastNameStatement* (.pdf)

WRITING SAMPLE

- Include an example of your best scholarly writing from an upper-level LSA course (a SOC course is preferred) that meets the following criteria:
 - not a journal entry, narrative, or reflection paper
 - preferably 2-5 pages in length
 - double-spaced with margins no smaller than one inch
- Name your writing sample document *LastNameSample* (.pdf)

LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

- Submit **TWO** letters of recommendation from University of Michigan faculty members or GSIs.
- The recommendations must include an evaluation of your ability to work independently.
- Letters from Department of Sociology faculty members or GSIs are strongly encouraged.
- Letters may arrive separately from your application, but **must arrive by Friday, November 2nd, 2018**. Instructors may send recommendations via e-mail to socadvisor@umich.edu.

ADDENDUM

- If there are extenuating circumstances regarding your application to the Honors Program in Sociology which you would like the selection committee to consider in making their decision about your admission (e.g. low academic performance in a particular semester), please explain the circumstances in an application addendum.
 - Name your addendum document *LastNameAddendum* (.pdf)
