

# How to interpret your Transfer Credit Student Summary Report

This guide explains how to interpret the Transfer Credit Student Summary Report (TCSSR) that every admitted LSA transfer student receives. The first couple of pages included definitions of key terms and concepts.

## **The types credit you will see on the TCSSR**

### **Equivalent Credit**

A transferable class determined to be directly equivalent to an LSA class will be listed with a U-M course subject, number, and title indicating that it will appear on your transcript as to that specific LSA course.

Courses that transfer as equivalent to a U-M course will count toward the LSA degree requirements in the same way that the equivalent U-M course does with the exception for the Race and Ethnicity requirement.

You can look up individual courses on the [LSA Course Catalog](#) to see what degree requirements they fulfill.

### **Departmental Credit**

A transferable class that does not directly match a specific LSA class but fits within the LSA curriculum will be listed with the department subject, 101X, 201X, or 301X as the course number, and "Departmental" instead of a course title.

Many courses that transfer as departmental credit have already been approved to count for specific LSA degree requirements. See the Transfer Guides to see what specific courses will count toward general degree requirements. To count these courses toward credit for majors and minors, you will need to have them evaluated by an advisor in the department of your major.

### **Interdepartmental Credit:**

A transferable class that contains content from multiple LSA departments will be posted as Interdepartmental credit with a subject of INTERSS, INTERHUM, INTERNS, or INTERID and will automatically count toward the Area Distribution requirements as:

- INTERSS courses for the Social Science Area Distribution
- INTERHUM courses for the Humanities Area Distribution
- INTERNS courses for the Natural Science Area Distribution
- INTERID courses for the Interdisciplinary Area Distribution

### **Transfer General Credit**

A transferable class that does not fit into any U-M subject will be listed as TRGENCR 101X: Departmental. Courses transferring as TRGENCR will not count toward any specific degree requirement but will be elective credit and the credit hours will count toward the 120 credit requirement.

## **How Credit Hours Transfer**

The number of credit hours that you earn for your U-M degree from your transfer credit will depend on the credit system used by the institution at which you took the classes.

### **Transferring credit from semester hour institutions**

If the school at which you completed your classes uses the same semester credit hour system as U-M, then you will earn the same number of credits for each class. For example, if you earned 4 credits at your previous school for a class, you will earn 4 credits at U-M. This will be true even if you are receiving equivalent credit for class that is a different number of credit hours at U-M. You may see that the number of credit hours are split between two U-M classes on your credit report, but the total number of credit hours will be the same.

### **Transferring credit from institutions that use a different credit hour system**

If the school at which you completed your classes uses a different credit hour system than U-M, then your credit hours will be converted to U-M semester hours. The conversion varies based on the school at which you took your classes, but the credit report will show the converted credit hours so you know exactly how many credits you will be transferring.
