Please mark all items with your camper's name! It is a camper's responsibility to keep track of all their belongings while at camp. To support campers' success in this area, we encourage families to label all belongings with a camper's first and last name and send all items in a bag or backpack.

<u>Snacks</u>

Please send a snack with your camper – both morning and afternoon! Camp Explorations provides plenty of water, lemonade, and the occasional popsicle, but a healthy snack really helps keep us going! **Please DO NOT send snacks that contain nuts.**
